Wage Rates: The Village of Combined Locks will abide by Wisconsin Statute Section 66.0903 as it relates to the wage rates that will be paid on this project.

No bid shall be received unless accompanied by a certified check or bid bond equal to at least five (5) percent of the bid, payable to the Village of Combined Locks, as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, the bidder will execute and file the proper contract and bond within 10 days from the date that the contract is awarded. In the event that the bidder fails to file such contract and bond within the time set by the Village, the check or bid bond shall be forfeited to the Village as liquidated damages.

The Village of Combined Locks reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or to accept any bid deemed in the best interest of the Village and to waive any informalities in the bidding.
